



Notice of Race 2011 – 2012 Season

The Club's points score racing program commences on the 4th September and finishes on 1st April 2012. These races are organized by Lake Cootharaba Sailing Club Inc.

1 Rules:

The races will be governed by the current rules as defined in the *Racing rules of sailing*. Trailables are governed by Yachting Australia Special regulations Part 1 Category 6

1.3 Off the beach boats are governed by Yachting Australia Special regulations Part 2

2 Eligibility and Entry:

The races are open to all off the beach boats and trailables. They will compete in the following Divisions:

Division 1 Monohulls, Catamarans and Trailables.

Division 2 Boats with a yardstick over 150

Eligible boats enter by lodging their entry card and race fee, when it applies, at the race office at least one hour before of the scheduled start of a race.

Skippers and crews will be allowed to compete in three races before becoming members of Lake Cootharaba Sailing Club Inc.

3 Fees:

3.1 The fee for senior boats is \$10.00 per race and \$15.00 for two races per day.

3.2 The fee for Junior boats and Junior skipper and crew sailing in Division 1 is \$5.00 per race and \$7.00 for two races per day.

3.3 Season and series nominations fees are as listed on the series entry form.

3.4 Allboats, Cat Challenge and Monomaster regattas require separate nomination.

4 Schedule of races:

4.1 The racing program and trophy schedule is listed elsewhere in this program.

4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1100 hours for morning races and 1330 hours for afternoon races.

5 Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions are available at the race office.

6 Scoring

6.1 Season Points Score: 29 races scheduled, 18 races are required to be completed to constitute a series. When 18 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding 20% of her worst scores.

6.2 Club Championship: 12 races scheduled, 9 races are required to be completed to constitute a series. When 9 to 12 races are completed a boat's series score will be total of her race scores excluding her worst 3 scores. When less than 9 races are completed a boat's series score will be total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

6.3 Spring series: 7 races scheduled, 5 races to be completed to constitute a series.

When 6 or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding of her worst score.

6.4 Summer series; 8 races scheduled, 5 races to be completed to constitute a series.

When 6 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding of her worst score.

6.5 Autumn Series: 5 races scheduled, 4 races to be completed to constitute a series.

When 5 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding of her worst score.

6.6 Duty crews will be scored average points.

6.7 Crews not assisting in duty roster may have a scoring penalty applied to the series score.
