The Organising Authority is the Lake Cootharaba Sailing Club Inc on behalf of the MG Skiff Association of QLD.

**Regatta Venue**

Lake Cootharaba Sailing Club Inc, Boreen Point Queensland. (LCSC).

## 1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules Of Sailing and the prescriptions and special regulations of Yachting Australia; Rules and By-Laws of the Qld Skiff Association of QLD, the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

## 2 Advertising

The regatta is classified as a Category C, in accordance with ISAF regulation 20, and the prescription of Yachting Australia. Competing boats may be required to display advertising of the Event Sponsors as provided by the organising authority.

## 3. Eligibility

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to all MG14, MGB and Sportskiff class yachts that are registered with a state or Territory MG Association
- 3.2. Both crewmembers of each yacht must be financial members for the 2007-2008 season of a club which is affiliated with its State Yachting Body.
- 3.3 Both members of a yachts crew must be a financial member for the 2007-2008 season, of a State or Territory MG Association.

## 4. Entries

- 4.1 Entries and appropriate acknowledgement, together with an entry fee of \$100.00 to be lodged with Lake Cootharaba Sailing Club Inc. 24 Boreen Parade, Boreen Point. Qld 4565. before the 15<sup>th</sup> of December 2007.
- 4.2 Late entries may be accepted up 28<sup>th</sup> December 2007. At the discretion of the organising authority, however, such entries will incur an additional fee of \$40.00

## 5. Schedule of Events

### 5.1 Registration

Both the skipper and crew of each yacht must attend registration between 9.30am and 11.00am on the 27<sup>th</sup> December 2007 or the 28<sup>th</sup> of Dec. 2007 to be conducted in the clubhouse of LCSC before racing.

### 5.2 Measurement and safety checks

All yachts shall have a safety checklist completed at registration and shall be made available for a safety and measurement check at any time during the Championships.

### 5.3 Briefing

A briefing shall be conducted on the 28th December 2007 at 11.00am at the LCSC clubhouse.

A briefing will be conducted for the invitation race at 12.30pm on the 27<sup>th</sup> of Dec. at LCSC.

- 5. Presentation of Trophies**

Trophies will be awarded at a presentation dinner held at the clubhouse of LCSC commencing at 6.30pm.
- 6. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing instructions shall be available at registration.
- 7. Measurement and Equipment**
  - 7.1 Each boat shall ensure a valid measurement of sails and equipment intended to be used in the regatta has been performed as required by the Class rules and Class Measurement Plate is attached and certificates held.

Should a competitor arrive at the Regatta with an unmeasured sail or equipment it **may** be measured after arrangement (in advance) with the Measurer.
  - 7.2 Competitors are reminded of their obligations regarding eligible equipment.

Reference to the Rules and By-laws of the MG Skiff Association of QLD and the MG14 Association of NSW Inc.
  - 7.3 Replacement of damaged sails, spars and foils may be permitted upon written request to the Race Committee. The Race Committee shall consider such request and permit or otherwise, such request in writing.
- 8. Racing Area**

Races will be held on Lake Cootharaba on the waters adjacent to Boreen Point.
- 9. Courses**

The courses will be triangles with windward leeward.
- 10. Scoring**

The low point scoring system, Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing shall apply. Eight (8) races are scheduled, of which five (5) shall be completed to constitute a series. If only five races are completed, each yachts series score shall be the total of her race scores without discard. If six (6) or more races are completed her worst single score will be excluded.
- 11. Sign on Sign off**

At least one member of the yachts crew will sign on before the start of each sailing day and sign off at the end of each sailing day. Sign on/off sheets will be located in the LCSC clubhouse. Failure to do so will incur a one minute penalty.

**12. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the regatta, subject to any unresolved protests. The winning competitors will receive the Championship Trophies to be held until next contested. Prizes for the following categories will be awarded, but not limited to:

**MG14's**

- Overall Scratch, "Young Guns"; Total crew age of 40yrs or less 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> "Open"; Any combined Age "Australian Champion" 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> "Masters"; Total crew age of 60yrs or over 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> "Senior Masters"; Total crew age of 80yrs or greater 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>
- Handicap Winners  
In all the age groups above 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>

First place by Overall Scratch Results 1<sup>st</sup>- 3<sup>rd</sup> and Handicap 1<sup>st</sup>- 3<sup>rd</sup>

**SPORTSKIFF's**

First place by Overall Scratch Results 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> and Handicap 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>

First placegetters by Overall Scratch Results will not be eligible for first place on Handicap

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**14 INSURANCE**

All competing boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than AUD \$5,000,000. All owners and/or competitors who sign the Entry Form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Competitors may be asked for a certificate of currency at sign on.

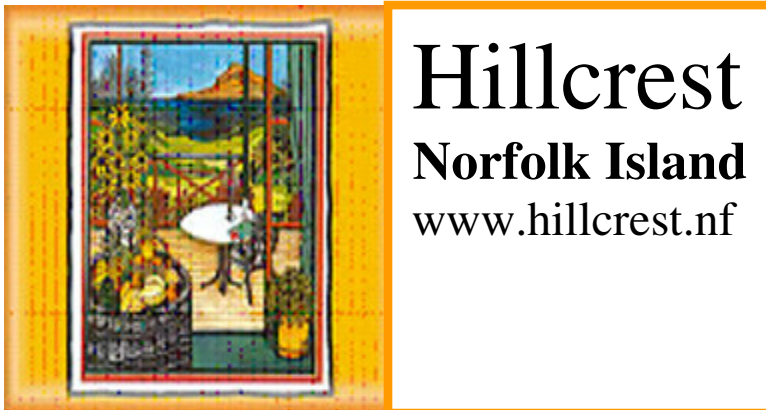
We hope that all competitors will utilise the fantastic facilities of LCSC and join us for some fun social times.
